This deed dated on 18 Aug 1848 settled land rights that belonged to the heirs of deceased sisters, Mary Wright Wilgus and Nancy Wright Hoy. Mary Wright Wilgus had 14 heirs listed, and most importantly to the Hoy family, the six heirs of Nancy Wright Hoy were named as John Stacy & Margaaret Hoy, Thomas & Jane Hoy and George & Mary Hoy from Perry County, Ohio.

1. Orphan's Court records of 13 Sep 1831 in Greene County, PA establish the children of John Hoy.

I visited her there with my mother, Uncle Stace Hoy and his wife Henrietta in 1941, when I was five years old.

The following note about a trip home to Ohio was found in Amy's bible. It is copied here from a published book on the Lanning family..

Mrs. Amy Hoy left Dawson, Nebraska, Monday, June the seventh, 1909, on the three o'clock train and fifty seven minutes in the afternoon, for Columbus, Ohio, and got to Mrs. Lusella Nixon's Tuesday at eight o'clock, June the eight.

Left Columbus, Thursday, June the tenth for Hawks, Ohio, to Nora Mahaffey, Got to Hawks, Thursday evening at seven o'clock. It cost twenty dollars and forty cents from Dawson, Nebraska to Columbus, Ohio. It cost one dollar and seventy five cents from Columbus, Ohio to Hawks, Ohio. From Hawks, Ohio, to Straitsville, Ohio cost one dollar and five cents. It cost twenty five cents to go on a hack from Shawnee back to Straitsville, and one dollar and five cents from Straitsville back to Hawks.

From Hawks to Shawnee and from Shawnee to Colubbus, all together cost two dollars and a quarter. From Columbus to Dawson it cost seventeen dollars and thirty cents.

Changes going to Ohio -

First change: Saint Louis

Second change: Indianapolis, in the morning.

Third change: Springfield, in the evening.

Forth change: was at Columbs, At Aunt Lusella.

Fifth change was at Logan, Ohio, Stop at Hawks at Aunt Nora's.

Changes coming to Nebr.

Got on at Shawnee, first change was at Summerset, Ohio. Got off at olumbus, second change left Columbus at seven in the morning.

Got to Chicago a little after five in evening.

Left Chicago and got to Lincoln, Nebr. November third at ten o'clock in the morning - fourth change was at Wymore, Nebr. from Wymore to Dawson, on the Three o'oclock and fifty seven train.

I left Washington the twenty day of May and came to San Francisco Cal. I like this country. We are having nice weather. I haven't saw any snow this winter. The weather is like summer here now. What has become of Jim Hoy? Is he in Nebraska yet or has he come back to Ohio. Well John rite soon and tell me all news. I will rite more when I hear from you. Yours truly, Geo. Hoy
